A. Briefly summarize the Measurable Goal identified in the SWMPP in this reporting period.

The Town's goal to reduce the impacts of storm events through education is intended to raise aw areness of the impacts of storm water. The Town works to accomplish this through the distribution of educational/planning materials, discussions at Town meetings, project kickoff meetings, on-site meetings with residents, the posting of materials on the Town's website, and the creation of the Community Storm water Forum, meets monthly to discuss storm water issues.

B. Briefly summarize the observations that indicated the overall effectiveness of this Measurable Goal.

The Town experienced a general decrease in adverse storm in pacts that appeared to be attributable to private actions taken by residents and the implementation of residential storm water BM Ps. 




