TRI CITY VALLEYCATS POLICE SERVICES

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

This Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) is between the Town of North Greenbush, hereinafter referred to as the "Town", and the North Greenbush Police Benevolent Association, hereinafter referred to as the "Union".

WHEREAS, the Town and the Union wish to enter into an agreement with regard to the terms and conditions of employment of Town employees with regard to the provision of the Tri City ValleyCats' security by employees in the Police Sergeant and Police Officer titles and, when necessary due to vacant shifts, by the Police Chief and Police Lieutenant;

WHEREAS, it is expressly understood by the Union and the Town that utilizing Town Police Officer employee titles, as identified above, to provide security for the Tri City ValleyCats will be done so in a manner to avoid the expenditure of regular and overtime personal service monies from the Police Department Budget, except during emergency situations;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein, the Town and the Union agree as follows:

- 1. With regard to the provision of security being provided to the Tri City ValleyCats':
 - a. Tri City ValleyCats' security work will be provided by employees in the Town Police Sergeant, Town Police Officer, and when necessary, Town Police Chief and Town Police Lieutenant titles only.
 - b. Tri City ValleyCats' security work will be compensated at the flat rate of Forty-two dollars (\$42.00) per hour but will receive at a minimum two (2) hours of pay for said work. Security Detail Officers shall receive no other compensations.
 - c. Game cancellations will be communicated to the North Greenbush Police Department at 518-283-5323. Dispatch will then notify the officer who is scheduled. The officer will receive no pay for the detail. If Tri City ValleyCats does not make such notification and the officer arrives for the detail, a minimum of one (1) hour of detail rate will be paid. Cancellations that occur during midgame will result in the officer receiving either the two (2) hour minimum of detail rate or their actual time worked at detail rate, whichever is greater.
 - d. Bidding of Tri City ValleyCats' security will be done at least Two (2) weeks in advance of the date to be worked.
 - e. Tri City ValleyCats' security work shall be bid out to off-duty police sergeants and off-duty police officers first, on the basis of seniority without regard to title. In the event that the work cannot be filled by off-duty sergeants or police officers, it may be filled by the Lieutenant or Chief of Police or by an on-duty police sergeant or police officer providing this does not affect the minimum staffing level as outlined in the current Union Contract. For clarity in this MOA there are no minimum staffing levels authorized for this security detail.

f. Those working the Tri City ValleyCats' security will report to police headquarters in order to bring a marked patrol unit with them to the security detail. All departmental policies & procedures and dress codes will be followed while on the security detail.

g. Tri City ValleyCats may hold events other than regular and post-season baseball games. These events will be staffed and compensated the same as the baseball games with the exception that Tri City ValleyCats may request more than one

officer for the event.

- 2. Pursuant to the Taylor Law, the Town reserves the right to bring this MOA to the Town Board for ratification and final approval, and the Union reserves the right to bring this MOA to its membership for ratification and final approval.
- 3. This MOA shall set no precedent in any further or future matters between the Town and the Union and shall sunset at the end of the Tri City ValleyCats' 2023 season or post-season home games.
- 4. Further and exclusively only to the Tri City ValleyCats' Security Detail contained herein, if the Tri City ValleyCats opt out of its agreement with the Town or fails to meet its obligations under that agreement, the Chief of Police, as directed by the Town Board, shall suspend scheduling for this Special Detail.
- 5. An agreement with the Town and the Tri City ValleyCats' may renew annually; there is no guarantee of this arrangement or Special Detail opportunity.
- 6. Either the Town or the Union may provide the other party with 30-day written notice of their intent to opt out of the agreement. Both parties agree to meet before any opt out is exercised.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

This Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) is between the Town of North Greenbush, hereinafter referred to as the "Town" and the North Greenbush Police Benevolent Association, hereinafter referred to as the "Union".

WHEREAS, the Town and Union are parties to a Collective Bargaining Agreement (the "CBA") concerning the terms and conditions of employment of Town employees in the titles of full-time police sergeant, full-time and part-time police officer and full-time and part-time dispatchers; and

WHEREAS, said CBA will expire on December 31, 2025; This agreement amends Article XV, Sections A2, A3, E, and F (Health, Medical and Dental Insurance) and will either be negotiated in the successor or incorporated into it as written; and

WHEREAS, the Town and the Union wish to enter into an agreement with regard to the terms and conditions of the Town's and Employee's contributions for Vision and Dental Insurance coverage.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein, the Town and Union agree as follows:

Dental Insurance

Active police members will have:

Individual coverage- Premium fully covered by Town

Family coverage- Premium shared by Town and Employee. Employee will pay for 50% of the difference between the Family rate and Individual rate. (Family Rate – Individual Rate / 2 = Employee contribution). Town will pay the remainder.

Police members who have retired prior to January 1st, 2017 will have:

Individual coverage- Premium fully covered by Town

Family coverage- Premium shared by Town and Employee. Employee will pay for 50% of the difference between the Family rate and Individual rate. (Family Rate – Individual Rate / 2 = Employee contribution). Town will pay the remainder.

Police members who have retired on January 1st, 2017 or after will have:

Individual coverage- Premium fully covered by Town

Family coverage- Premium shared by Town and Employee. Employee will pay for 50% of the difference between the Family rate and Individual rate. (Family Rate – Individual Rate / 2 = Employee contribution). Town will pay the remainder.

Vision Insurance

Active police members will have:

Individual coverage- Premium fully covered by the Town Family coverage- Premium fully covered by the Town

Police members who have retired prior to January 1st, 2017 will have:

Individual coverage- Premium fully covered by the Town Family coverage- Premium fully covered by the Town

Police members who have retired on January 1st, 2017 or after will have:

Individual coverage-Premium fully covered by the Town

Family coverage- Premium fully covered by the retiree

*If the retiree has a sick time balance pursuant to Article XIV, Sections F(2) and F(6) of the CBA, those funds shall be used to cover the retiree's portion of any contributions.

- 1. Pursuant to Taylor law, the Town reserves the right to bring this MOA to the Town Board for ratification and final approval, and the Union reserves the right to bring this MOA to its membership for ratification and final approval.
- 2. This Memorandum of Agreement constitutes the entire understanding between the Town and Union as to the provision of Vision and Dental Insurance contributions.
