Section 175-34. Schedule IX: Parking Prohibited

Section 175-34, Schedule IX of the North Greenbush Town Code entitled "Parking Prohibited" is hereby amended to add the following in alphabetical order:

Section I. Section 175-34 of the North Greenbush Town Code is hereby amended to include:

No parking on Bloomingrove Drive at the intersection of Bloomingrove Drive and US Route 4 (North Greenbush Road) to the intersection of Bloomingrove Drive and Washington Avenue Extension. This prohibition applies to both sides of the road.

Section II. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing it in the Office of the New York State Secretary of State.

WHEREAS, Section NY General Municipal Law §92-a authorizes public corporations to provide insurance plans for their employees; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of North Greenbush has determined that offering a life insurance benefit to its eligible employees is a necessary and proper action to attract and retain qualified personnel; and

WHEREAS, the offering of life insurance plan shall not have any impact on the finances of the Town.

Section 1. Establishment of Plan.

The Town Board hereby authorizes the establishment of a life insurance plan for Town employees.

Section 2. Eligibility.

The following employees shall be eligible to participate in the life insurance plan:

- All full-time employees.
- All regular part-time employees who are scheduled to work, on average, more than twenty (20) hours per week.
- Employees must satisfy any additional eligibility criteria established by the plan administrator, including any waiting periods.

Section 3. Benefit Details.

The Standard Life Insurance Company of New York offers a life insurance plan with a benefit of up to \$150,000 with no medical questions and a benefit of \$300,000 that requires the provision of medical information, a copy of the proposal is on file with the Town Clerk.

Section 4. Funding.

The premiums shall be covered by employee contributions.

Section 5. Authorization.

The Town Supervisor, or the Town Comptroller, is hereby authorized and directed to take all necessary and appropriate steps to implement this resolution, including but not limited to:

- Executing any and all contracts and agreements with an insurance carrier.
- Communicating the terms of the plan to eligible employees.
- Taking all other actions necessary to administer the life insurance program.

Section 6. Effective Date.

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
